

DRESS CODE

The purpose for a specific dress code for PRS is to provide employees comfort and safety while maintaining a productive and professional environment. The image and credibility of PRS is determined by its employees.

Personal Hygiene:

- Personal cleanliness is essential. Neatly trimmed beards and mustaches are permitted.
- Hair should be clean and well groomed and not extreme in style.
- Fingernails should be clean and neatly trimmed. Length of fingernails should not interfere with performance of duties.
- Frequent hand washing is required.

Personal Attire

- Clothing should be neat and clean. No blue jeans are allowed. Extreme style in dress and grooming are to be avoided.
- Casual wear (i.e. company shirts) may be worn any day of the week
- Shoes should be polished/cleaned regularly. Open-toed shoes are not allowed.
- Jewelry should not be extreme in style.
- Avoid heavy perfumes/colognes and excessive makeup.
- Hats are not allowed as part of the dress code.
